

SAILING INSTRUCTIONS for Laying-Up Race

Sunday 16 September 2007 HW 08.31 5.0 LW 14.59 1.3 m

RULES

This is a **FUN** event with the object of crossing the finish line as near as possible to 12.00. The target finish time will remain as 12.00 in the event of a postponed start being signalled (flag AP on committee boat). Boats should sail the course until the crew judge the time to alter course and sail normally to the feeder mark and finish line. **Any deliberate slowing down or other delaying tactics during the approach to the finish will be noted and severely penalised.** Without doubt this is the greatest test of sailing skill in the club's calendar.

The Mylor Yacht Club Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions and Course Card for 2007 apply in respect of Racing rules, safety, commercial shipping, divers, harbour restrictions and buoy positions.

START TIMES

10.20 Warning signal
10.25 Preparatory signal flag P displayed
10.30 Start for all boats flag P removed

STARTING LINE

The starting line will be an imaginary line between the mainmast of the Committee Boat flying an orange flag and club mark **Pw** (yellow cylindrical buoy off Penarrow point). Start in the direction of the first mark (approximately heading north).

COURSE The course uses a variety of marks and introduces a feeder mark before finishing.

Ck(s) **Jb(s)** **J(s)**
Repeat Ck(s) Jb(s) J(s) until time judged to go to

Feeder mark Gr(p) Finish

Don't forget to go around Gr (p) before finishing!

Re, Tu, Jb, Gr and So are yellow inflatable club marks and Pw is a cylindrical yellow club mark
J (St Just) is a port hand channel buoy, Ck (Carrick) is a starboard hand channel buoy.

FINISHING LINE

The finishing line will be between the main mast of the committee boat in a position to the south of Gr mark and a distance mark. Finish in the direction from the feeder mark Gr (approximately heading south).

SCORING

Boats start with 1000 points.

For finish times before 12.00 2 points will be deducted for each second early.

For finish times after 12.00 1 point will be deducted for each second late.

The OOD may also award points for fine looking boats, grovelling, fancy dress etc.

The OOD **will** deduct **HUGE NUMBERS** of points for any kind of **CHEATING** (and the team are very perceptive) such as poorly trimmed sails, towing buckets or keel-hauling crew members.

PRIZE GIVING WILL TAKE PLACE IN THE CLUBHOUSE DURING THE LUNCHTIME SESSION.
